REGISTRATION FEES:

Please note that once the teams have started playing games, the league is unable to refund the registration fees. Prior to the start of games the registration fee will be refunded if, after every effort, we are unable to resolve a problem that you may be encountering.

INSURANCE:

A portion of your fee goes to pay for liability medical insurance for the participants. The policy has a \$100,000.00 per incident limit with a deductible of \$100.00. A deductible is the amount that the participant is required to pay before the insurance company will pay anything. This is an **excess insurance** policy, which means that coverage is only payable after the participant has exhausted the limits of his/her family insurance. Proof that the family insurance policy limit has been reached is required to recover any money under this policy. If the participant does not have any family insurance, then this insurance becomes the primary insurance.

Parent Etiquette and Code of Conduct

Parent's Role

1. Be a good listener. Make your child feel important and let them know that he or she is contributing to a team effort.
2. Always be positive. Never criticize or demean your child. Be constructive and encouraging with your words and actions.
3. Attempt to attend all practices and games and give your support in a positive manner. Let the coach point out their mistakes and allow yourself to point out your child's positives.
4. Encourage your children to participate in all positions and aspects of the game. Do not force them.
5. Focus on your child's effort and performance, **not just on winning and losing.**
6. Remember your children participate in sports for their enjoyment and not yours.
7. Ensure your child is properly dressed and has the appropriate equipment for all practices and games. Let your child's coach know if your child will be unable to attend a game or practice.
8. NEVER leave your child unattended at anytime and ALWAYS encourage and inform them of not talking to, or leaving practices or games with, strangers.
9. Parents need to understand that your attitude, demeanor, body language and verbal statements can influence players, coaches, and other spectators. What do you want that message to be?
10. Make an effort to learn the rules and understand the game. This will allow you to enjoy the game to the fullest.
11. In competition someone always loses. If you win, do it gracefully and not boastfully. If you lose, do not allow your child to become negative.
12. *Should a problem arise, parents will contact a Board member or Parent Liaison to inform the Board of the problem and avoid adding to the "rumor mill".*

Parents Code of Conduct

Parents and spectators will not smoke, use tobacco products, consume alcohol, or use drugs on the fields during practices or games.

Parents and spectators will not use any obscenities or profanities at practices or games.

Parents and spectators will remain behind the designated area until the end of the game. Except if there is an injury to your child or weather that causes a stoppage of the game.

Parents and spectators will not threaten players, coaches, referees, or other spectators. Nor shall parents and spectators verbally or physically abuse any players, coaches, referees, or other spectators.

Parents and spectators will not yell, interfere, or attempt to influence the referee. Let the coaches at the appropriate time address the matter.

Parents and spectators shall not give instruction or direction to any player while on the field. That is the job of the coach.

Parents and spectators should at all times support their team with cheers and positive feedback. *The use of any type of noise making device while a game is in progress is prohibited*

Violation of these rules will not be tolerated and the following discipline will be applied. It will include but is not limited to an official warning by a referee, Board member, or your child's coach, being asked to remove yourself from the area to avoid further disruption, forfeiture of the game for your team, or removal from the league. Remember we all are here for the children. Since each incident is unique, each incident will be investigated and, should discipline be necessary, it will be administered based upon the totality of the circumstances surrounding that incident. Decisions by the Board are final.
